## **Enhanced Printing Solution for the Truepress Jet520 Series**

(Headquarters: Kyoto, Japan) will enhance its solutions for various printing business applications offered by the Truepress Jet520 series variable printing system. This will involve adding new optional functions, supporting new workflows, and expanding systems such as the automatic printing data creation system.

The Truepress Jet520 is an on-demand printing system that addresses the growing needs of the important themes of one-to-one marketing and work requiring an ultra-fast turnaround. It has been introduced not only in Europe, Japan, and the United States, but in emerging countries as well, and has established an excellent reputation around the world for its advanced capabilities, thus demonstrating Screen's quality leadership in global markets. Adopted as its controller, EQUIOS is next-generation workflow software that further promotes automation through high-speed RIP processing of PDF files and a superior color management system that facilitates high level color reproduction without requiring any specialized knowledge and skill. Furthermore, EQUIOS is linked with JetInspection, an inspection unit for a variable printing system, to support reprinting and the discharge of defect pages in post-press processing, and realize printing quality and ad quantity assurance system for advertisers. This will secure the accurate processing of large volumes of data at high speed. It is also possible to build a consistent production line from data submission through completion of the final product for books and newspapers. This relies on EQUIOS' automatic imposition function and JDF data exchange with a variety of vendors based on the EQUIOSNET Partnership Program. And, with a data submission environment that exploits the Internet, it makes "Web to Delivery" possible as well.
